Access

The museum is largely accessible for visitors with mobility impairments via the Exhibitions entrance at Museumpark 18. Ask a member of staff to show you the easiest route. Wheelchairs and buggies can be borrowed from the ticket desk. Reservations: +31 (0)10-44.19.475.

Please do not touch the artworks. Eating and drinking in the galleries is strictly prohibited. Large bags, rucksacks and umbrellas must be left in the cloakroom. Photography of the permanent collection is allowed for personal use, but without flash or tripod. Please be considerate of other visitors and do not make telephone calls in the galleries. In Museum Boijmans Van Beuningen general visiting conditions apply (available at the information desk upon request).

Museum shop

The museum shop stocks a wide range of books, cards and gifts. The shop can be visited without a ticket.

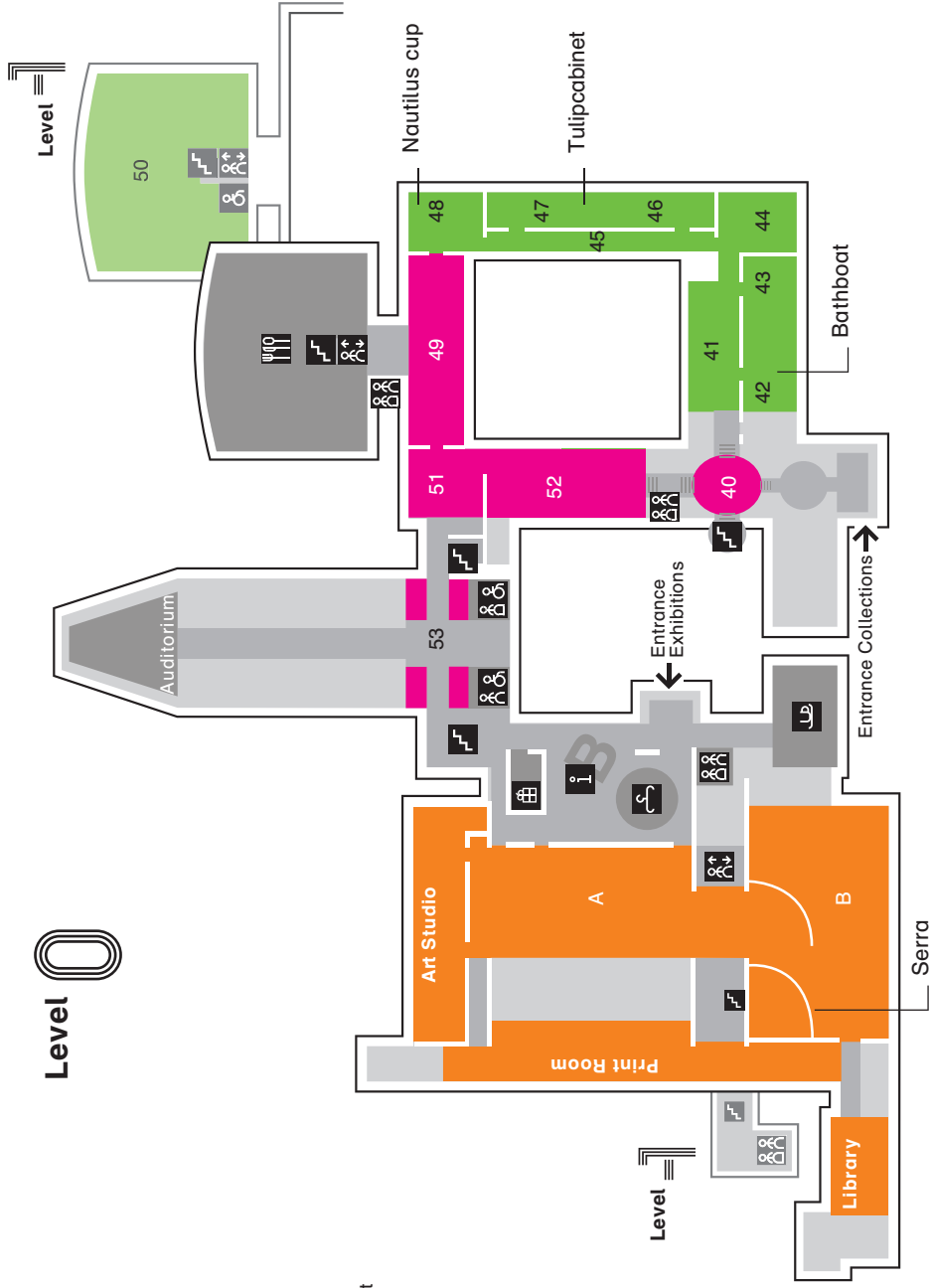

Welcome to Museum Boijmans Van Beuningen

Use this floor plan for information about the galleries, the collection, the library, refreshments, the museum shop and more.

Short visit (1 hour)

Focus on a specific part of the collection, or see one of the temporary exhibitions. You can also opt for a tour of the collection highlights indicated in the floor plan.

Long visit (2.5-4 hours)

Discover all the museum has to offer. Follow a Boijmans Tour through the collection, view the exhibitions, watch video artworks in Pipilotti Rist's installation 'Let Your Hair Down' (between galleries A and B), have lunch in the restaurant and visit the museum shop. The staff at the information desk can help you plan your visit.

Family visit

Besides our treasure hunts and tours for children we recommend you visit the following works with kids: the man climbing through the floor (gallery 18), the 'Infinity Mirror Room' (entrance area), the astonishing details of the 'Tower of Babel' (gallery 6), watch video's in a net above the stairwell (entrance area) and play football in the artwork in the courtyard.
